Governance

At Messingham Primary School we are fortunate to have a dedicated set of volunteer Governors who come from a wide background of experience and expertise. Governors are either elected as a parent/governor or are appointed as co-opted, Local Authority, or staff governors. There are termly meetings for the Full Governing Body, a resources committee as well as a school development committee. Governors also visit the school as part of learning walks and to be visible to the children and staff. Our mental health and well-being governor also regularly visits the school where staff can meet confidentially to discuss any ongoing concerns. Training is also available for our governors through the Local Authority.

Link Governors

At Messingham Primary School all of our governors take on the role of link governor where they help support and monitor the effectiveness of individual subjects. These monitoring roles are decided at the start of each Academic year and governors either meet or have termly phone conversations, as well as the usual Governor visits in order to report back to the governing body.
