

## National Tutoring Covid Catch Up Funding

Messingham Primary School has received Catch up Funding in two blocks. The first was in November for £5060 and the second in February for £6980 giving a total of **£12040**

To ensure that no child is left behind the money has been spent on ensuring that the children have access to resources that supported their learning through the lockdown as well as basic resources to assist when they returned to lockdown on March 8<sup>th</sup>. There was also timely interventions from November to December in Key stage 1 so that the class teacher could work with children on developing their phonics (see below)

Additional funds left are to be used to instigate phonics support for children in Year R and Year 1. Additional teacher appointed from June 7<sup>th</sup> until July 12<sup>th</sup>. Total cost will exceed the £1932.81 that is left from the catch up funding given to the school but will help with the costs of this additional member of staff for the summer 2 term.
